To ensure our graduates are prepared for their big evening, the final weeks of June will be dedicated to rehearsals and preparations:

Here is a detailed look at what the students will be studying in June.

Reading

This semester, students will begin working with slightly more complex reading books. These texts include longer sentences and introduce a wider range of new vocabulary to support language development. As students engage with these books, they will be encouraged to focus on comprehension, fluency, and word recognition. This progression will help strengthen their confidence as readers and prepare them for more advanced reading tasks later in the year.

Core material

The core material books are bright, colourful, and filled with engaging pictures that help capture and maintain students' interest. These visuals support understanding and make reading more enjoyable for young learners. The books include many fun and age-appropriate stories that use complete sentences and introduce basic grammar points.

Through repeated exposure to these structures, students are able to develop their spoken English skills, improve sentence formation, and gain confidence in expressing themselves orally.

Week 3 - Paired selection: From Horse to Plane

Weeks 4 & 5 - Shared Read: A Look at Breakfast

Phonics

This book has various exercises that teach a variety of phonics spelling rules. We go through the exercise as a group to make sure they understand, then they go off and try for themselves.

Week 1 - Plurals

Weeks 2 & 3 - Inflectional endings

Week 4 - High-frequency words

Week 5 - Review

Grammar

There are two grammar books, a workbook and a textbook. The textbook is completed at school and the workbook completed in unison as homework.

Week 1 - Test Your Grammar - was/wasn't/were/weren't . Writing verbs in the past tense.

Week 2 - Past Tense: Negative and Questions - did/didn't. Completing dialogues.

Week 3 - Future Tense: Will/Won't

Week 4 - Future Tense: Will Questions

Week 5 - Test Your Grammar - Review

Writing

The writing book has many exercises such as fill in the blank sentences, descriptive writing, writing about a topic, or writing a letter.

Week 1 - Reading Comprehension: Directions

Week 2 - Prepositions of Place.

Week 3 - Reading directions and drawing a picture that follows the directions.

Week 4 - Matching directions to pictures. Draw your own treasure maps.

Week 5 - Review: Prepositions

MPM Math

The MPM math series is an effective resource for helping students understand and master basic math concepts. The books are bright and colourful, which helps keep students engaged and motivated. In addition, the series includes a variety of hands-on apparatus that students can use to explore concepts and solve problems in a concrete and meaningful way. These materials support active learning and help students develop strong problem-solving skills and mathematical understanding.

Week 1 - Shape and colour matching. Spatial Concept: Quadrant relative position.

Inequalities comparing exercises. Coin value counting.

Week 2 - Directional and procedural path tracing. Shape matching and counting exercises.

Week 3 - Logical reasoning. Counting and addition exercises. Combination and separation of numbers. Ordinal number sorting exercises.

Week 4 - Comparing subtraction exercises. Addition and shape/function corresponding exercises. Money subtraction exercises.

Week 5 - Prepare for Graduation

Song and Dance

We have Song and Dance class every morning from 9:00 to 9:30. This class is a great opportunity for students to energise themselves at the start of the day and prepare for learning. A variety of songs are used that incorporate exercise and dance movements, helping students develop their motor skills, coordination, and body awareness. This fun and active routine also supports focus, confidence, and positive classroom engagement throughout the day.

Weeks 3 - 5 - Antonyms

Thematic Activities

Thematic activities provide students with the opportunity to learn about different countries or specific festivals in an engaging and meaningful way. These activities take place once a week for one hour, and each chosen theme is explored over the course of one month. This month's theme will be about International culture.

Library

Once a week, the class will visit the library, where I will read aloud to the students and allow each child to choose a book to take back to the classroom for the week. This encourages independence and helps foster a love of reading. If time allows, I will also read a selection of these books to the class and ask comprehension questions to support understanding, listening skills, and engagement with the stories.

Thank you for taking the time to read about the activities and learning experiences planned for your children. I hope this overview has given you a clear picture of what we are working on in the classroom.

歡迎閱讀無尾熊班六月份的班級通訊！

隨著學年即將結束，我們很高興宣布，無尾熊班的畢業典禮將於今年七月舉行。為了讓我們的畢業生為重要的晚會做好準備，六月的最後幾週將專注於排練與準備：

音樂表演：學生將練習兩首歌曲。一首是 K5 年級全體共同演出的合唱曲，另一首則是專為無尾熊班準備的特別歌曲。

以下是學生六月份學習內容的詳細介紹。

閱讀課程（Reading）

本學期，學生將開始閱讀內容稍微進階的讀本。這些書籍包含較長的句子，並引入更多新詞彙，以促進語言學習的發展。在閱讀過程中，學生將被鼓勵專注於對內容的理解能力、閱讀流暢度以及單字辨識。這樣的進階學習能幫助孩子建立閱讀自信，並為之後更高階的閱讀任務做好準備。

主教材課程（Core Material）

核心教材書籍色彩鮮明、插圖豐富，能有效吸引並維持學生的學習興趣。這些視覺元素有助於理解，讓閱讀變得更有意思。書中包含許多符合年齡層、富有趣味的故事，並使用完整句型

來介紹基礎文法概念。透過反覆接觸這些句型結構，學生能逐步提升口說能力、加強造句技巧，並建立自信，勇於用英語表達自己。

第 1 週 — Shared Read: 《Life At Home》

第 2 週 — Anchor Text: 《Long Ago and Now》

第 3 週 — Paired Selection: 《From Horse to Plane》

MPM 數學

MPM 數學系列是幫助學生理解並掌握基礎數學概念的有效教材。教材色彩豐富，能提高學生的學習動機與專注力。此外，課程中也包含許多實際操作教具，讓學生透過具體操作探索概念並解決問題。這些教材能促進主動學習，並幫助孩子建立良好的問題解決能力與數學理解力。

第 1 週 — 形狀與顏色配對、空間概念（象限位置）、不等式比較、硬幣價值計算

第 2 週 — 路徑方向追蹤、形狀配對與計數

第 3 週 — 邏輯推理、計數與加法、數字組合與分解、序數排序

第 4 週 — 減法比較、加法與形狀／功能對應、金錢減法

第 5 週 — 畢業準備

發音課程（Phonics）

本教材包含多種拼讀規則練習。課堂上會先一起講解，再讓學生自行練習。

第 1 週 — 複數（Plurals）

第 2–3 週 — 字尾變化（Inflectional Endings）

第 4 週 — 高頻單字（High-frequency Words）

第 5 週 — 複習（Review）

文法課程（Grammar）

此堂課我們運用 Space 系列的二本書(Textbook、Workbook)，交互使用。

《Grammar Space 3》對孩子們來說會相當熟悉，因為它是《Grammar Space 2》的延續。孩子們會把作業本帶回家，作為每週的家庭作業來完成。

第 1 週 — 文法測驗：was/wasn't/were/weren't；過去式動詞練習

第 2 週 — 過去式：否定句與問句（did/didn't）；完成對話

第 3 週 — 未來式：Will/Won't

第 4 週 — 未來式問句

第 5 週 — 文法總複習

寫作課程（Writing）

寫作練習包含：填空句、描述寫作、主題寫作、書信寫作

第 1 週：— 閱讀理解：方向指示

第 2 週 — 地點介系詞（Prepositions of Place）

第 3 週 — 閱讀指示並依照內容畫圖

第 4 週 — 圖片與方向配對；繪製自己的藏寶圖

第 5 週 — 複習：介系詞

歌曲律動 (Song and Dance)

每天早上 9:00–9:30 為歌曲與舞蹈時間，幫助孩子在一天開始時活動身體、提升專注力。課程結合音樂、運動與舞蹈，促進動作協調、肢體覺察，也有助於培養自信與正向的學習態度。

主題活動 (Thematic Activities)

主題活動為學生提供了一個機會，專注於學習特定國家或節日的相關知識。主題活動每週一次，時長一小時，每個主題將持續一個月。

體能課程 (P.E)

體能課提供了孩子們釋放能量、提高運動技能和建立社交技能的機會。孩子們喜歡這堂課，它可以消耗我們多餘的熱能並更專注於其他活動及學習。

圖書借閱/故事時間 (Library)

每周一次，我們會去圖書館閱讀英文故事書。我會為孩子們朗讀，並讓他們每人選擇一本書借閱回家，這是一堂很受孩子們喜歡的課程，因為孩子們喜歡聽老師講有趣的故事，同時欣賞書中的圖片。並借閱一本書，帶回家和爸爸、媽媽們享受親子共讀的樂趣。
