Hello Eagle Class Parents,

June was a very exciting and successful month for the K3 Eagle Class. We are incredibly proud of the children for their wonderful efforts during the Reading Competition. Each student worked hard to prepare, and it was rewarding to see their confidence and reading abilities shine during the event. We would also like to thank parents for their support with practicing at home, as this played an important role in the children's success.

Another highlight of the month was our Dragon Boat Festival celebration, which provided a fun and memorable activity day for the students. The children enjoyed learning about the traditions and culture surrounding the festival while participating in special activities with their classmates. These experiences help create lasting memories and strengthen our classroom community.

As we look ahead to July, we are excited for an important milestone as the children prepare to move upstairs into the new K4 classroom. This transition marks their promotion to the "big boy and girl" class, and we know they are ready to embrace the new challenges and responsibilities that come with becoming senior kindergarten students. It is wonderful to see how much they have grown this year, and we look forward to continuing this learning journey together. Now, let's take a closer look at what we have been learning in each subject area.

Reading

The children have continued to make steady progress in Reading as we begin preparing for the upcoming Reading Competition. Throughout our daily lessons, we have maintained a strong emphasis on pointing while reading, an important habit that helps children track words accurately, connect spoken sounds with printed text, and develop stronger fluency and comprehension skills. We encourage families to continue using this method during reading practice at home whenever possible. Students who have been practicing consistently are showing noticeable improvement in confidence and accuracy, while those with less frequent practice are finding it increasingly difficult to keep pace. At this stage, regular daily reading, even for a few minutes, can make a tremendous difference in a child's progress.

Phonics

In Phonics, the students have been working diligently through their worksheets and workbooks while strengthening their understanding of initial sounds, middle short vowel sounds, and listening skills. These foundations are essential for helping children sound out and read simple words independently. In addition to phonics practice, we have been expanding vocabulary using familiar words and expressions that students can apply naturally in daily conversations. Combining phonics with practical language helps students improve not only their reading ability but also their confidence in speaking and communicating in English throughout the school day.

The July schedule is as follows:

Week 1: P196, 197, 198, 203

(reviewing short vowel 'e')

Week 2: P204, 205, 206, 209

(short vowels review)

Week 3: catch-up and review

MPM Math (Multiple Practice Module)

The students continue to enjoy our hands-on MPM Math activities and especially look forward to using the learning boxes and materials. Alongside developing math concepts, we are also focusing on listening carefully and following instructions, with students earning points for demonstrating good self-control and responsible use of materials. Academically, we have been practicing matching activities, counting exercises, and speaking in complete sentences using structures such as "there is," "there are," and "how many." Students are also learning to add descriptive adjectives to their answers, such as "There are six red apples and four yellow bananas," helping them develop both mathematical understanding and spoken English skills simultaneously.

This coming month's schedule looks like this:

Week 1: B5: P07-10

Week 2: B5: P11-14

Week 3: B5: P15-18

Gross/Fine Motor Skills

Through a variety of coloring, tracing, cutting, and gluing activities, the children have been strengthening their fine motor skills and improving the hand control necessary for writing and other classroom tasks. Particular attention has been given to letter formation and vocabulary-related activities that support our classroom themes. These exercises help develop grip strength, concentration, and coordination while encouraging students to complete tasks independently and with increasing confidence. It has been wonderful to see the students becoming more comfortable and precise when using pencils, scissors, and other classroom tools.

July will look a bit like this:

Week 1: Tracing cvc words in word families

Week 2: Color, trace and match cvc words

Week 3: Reviews of word families and alphabet writing forms

Hello Eagle Class Parents,

六月對 K3 Eagle 班而言，是充滿收穫與喜悅的一個月。我們為孩子們在閱讀比賽中的優異表現感到十分驕傲。每位學生都認真投入準備，在比賽當天展現出良好的閱讀能力與自信，是對平日努力學習最好的成果。同時，也誠摯感謝家長在家中持續陪伴孩子練習閱讀，這份支持對孩子們能夠順利完成比賽發揮了重要的作用。

本月另一項精彩的活動是端午節慶祝活動。孩子們透過豐富有趣的課程與體驗，認識端午節的由來、文化與傳統習俗，並與同學共同參與各項節慶活動。這些充滿樂趣的學習經驗，不僅讓孩子留下美好的回憶，也進一步增進了班級凝聚力與同儕互動。展望七月，我們將迎來孩子們幼兒園生活中的一個重要里程碑——升上樓上的 K4 新教室。這代表孩子們即將晉升為幼兒園的中班生（K4），開始迎接更多新的挑戰與責任。我們相信，每位孩子都已做好準備，迎接這個嶄新的學習階段。回顧這一年，能夠看見孩子們在各方面持續成長，令人感到十分欣慰，也期待未來繼續陪伴他們邁向更多的學習與成長。接下來，讓我們一起看看本月各科課程的學習內容與重點。

Reading

孩子們在閱讀課程中持續展現穩定的進步，並逐步為即將到來的閱讀比賽做好準備。在每日的閱讀課程中，我們仍持續強調「指讀（pointing while reading）」的重要性。這項閱讀習慣能幫助孩子正確追蹤文字位置，建立語音與文字之間的連結，並有效提升閱讀流暢度與理

解能力。我們也鼓勵家長在家陪伴孩子閱讀時，持續採用相同的指讀方式，以建立一致的閱讀習慣。

目前可以明顯觀察到，能夠持續在家與學校規律練習的學生，在閱讀的自信心、準確度與流暢度方面都有顯著提升；相對地，練習較不固定的學生，隨著課程內容逐漸加深，將較難跟上整體學習進度。在現階段，即使每天僅安排幾分鐘的閱讀練習，也能對孩子的閱讀能力與學習成效帶來相當顯著的幫助。

Phonics

在自然發音（Phonics）課程中，學生們持續透過練習單與教材認真學習，逐步加強對字首音（initial sounds）、單字中間短母音（middle short vowel sounds）以及聽音辨識能力的理解。這些基礎能力是孩子未來能夠獨立拼讀與閱讀簡單單字的重要基石。

除了自然發音的學習之外，我們也持續擴充學生的詞彙量，運用孩子們熟悉的單字與生活化的常用語，幫助他們逐步將所學自然地應用於日常對話中。透過結合自然發音訓練與實用語言學習，不僅能有效提升孩子的閱讀能力，也能增強他們在校園生活中使用英語溝通與表達的信心。

Week 1: P196, 197, 198, 203

(reviewing short vowel 'e')

Week 2: P204, 205, 206, 209

(short vowels review)

Week 3: catch-up and review

MPM Math (Multiple Practice Module)

在 MPM 數學課程中，學生們依然非常喜歡各項實作活動，尤其期待使用學習盒及各種操作教材。除了學習數學概念之外，課程也持續培養孩子仔細聆聽指令及遵守課堂規範的能力。學生若能展現良好的自我控制能力，並正確使用教材，即可獲得點數獎勵，藉此培養責任感與良好的學習習慣。

在學習內容方面，本月持續進行配對活動、數數練習，以及使用完整句型進行口語表達。孩子們練習運用「**there is**」、「**there are**」及「**how many**」等句型回答問題，並逐步學習在句子中加入形容詞，使描述更加完整且具體。例如，學生會練習說出：「**There are six red apples and four yellow bananas.**」透過將數學概念與英語口語練習相結合，不僅提升了孩子的數學理解能力，也同步增進其英語表達能力與口語自信。

This coming month's schedule looks like this:

Week 1: B5: P07-10

Week 2: B5: P11-14

Week 3: B5: P15-18

Gross/Fine Motor Skills

透過各種著色、描線、剪貼與黏貼活動，孩子們持續發展精細動作能力，並提升書寫及其他課堂操作所需的手部控制能力。課程中特別著重於字母的正確書寫以及與課堂主題相關的詞彙學習，讓孩子在練習精細動作的同時，也能強化語文能力。這些活動有助於增進握筆力量、專注力與手眼協調能力，同時培養學生獨立完成學習任務的能力與自信心。我們也很高興看到，孩子們在使用粗蠟筆、剪刀及其他課堂工具時，操作已變得更加熟練、穩定且精確。
