Hello Parents,

This month marks the final month of the semester, during which we will continue with our regular curriculum. Students will focus on completing key topics, reinforcing essentials skills, and preparing thoroughly for the end-of-term assessments. .

Reading Wonders (Core Material)

This month, as we wrap up the final month of the semester, our core materials will focus on building critical thinking, organization, and environmental awareness. In the first week, students will be learning and reading “Problem Solvers”, developing strategies for tackling challenges and applying logical thinking. During the second week, we will explore “Sort It Out”, strengthening classification, categorization, and problem-solving skills. In the third week, the class will dive into “Protect Our Earth”, learning about environmental responsibility, sustainability, and ways we can care for our planet.

Conversation/Grammar

In our conversation class this month, students will actively practice spoken English through interactive discussions. During the first week, the focus will be on verbs, helping students identify, and use verb forms confidently in everyday conversations. In the second and 3rd weeks, we will concentrate on the simple present tense with “have/has”

Phonics

In our phonics class this month, students will strengthen their foundational reading skills through targeted review and practice. During the first week, we will review the short vowel, “e”, focusing on sound recognition. The second week will feature a comprehensive short vowels reviewing, “ a e i o u”. In the third week, we will dedicate time to catch-up and overall review, ensuring all students have understood these essential phonics patterns before the end of the semester.

Reading Class

In our reading class this month, students will enjoy a series of stories featuring the character Tiny as we wrap up the final month of the semester. During the first week, we will read “Tiny Goes Camping”, exploring themes of outdoor adventure, friendship, and problem solving. In the second week, the class will dive into “Tiny the Birthday Dog”, focusing on celebration and surprises. For the third week, we will read “Hi-Ho Tiny” reinforcing reading fluency and completing the story series through discussions and related activities.

Math

In our math class this month, as we complete the final month of the semester, students will build essential foundational skills, through progressive practice. During the first week we will focus on counting exercises, shape recognition, and spatial concepts to strengthen number sense and visual understanding. In the second week, we will add non-directional path tracing activities, helping students develop fine motor skills, concentration, and pre-writing abilities. For the third week, we will incorporate shape matching, introducing the basic concept of sets, and practice counting amounts within sets.

Thematic Activity

This final month of the semester, our thematic activities will celebrate the season of Summer. Students will engage in discussions, and arts and crafts around summer experiences including sunny weather, beach adventures, outdoor play, and seasonal changes. Making meaningful connections to the world around them.

Physical Education

In our Physical Education (PE) sessions this month, the children enjoy a mixture of free play and variety of fun movement activities and games that help develop their gross motor skills, coordination, balance, and teamwork. We focus on running, jumping, stacking, and simple team games to keep them active, healthy and energetic while building confidence in their physical abilities.

Song and Dance

In our song and dance class this month, as we enjoy the final month of the semester with singing and movement activities in the first week we will learn the song “The more we get together”. In the second and 3rd week we will learn to sing Twinkle twinkle little star.

Reading Class

Math

本月為本學期的最後一個月，數學課程將透過循序漸進的練習，幫助孩子建立重要的基礎能力。第一週將進行數數練習、形狀辨識與空間概念活動，以強化數感與視覺理解能力。第二週將加入非方向性的路徑描寫活動，協助孩子發展精細動作能力、專注力及書寫前能力。第三週則進行形狀配對活動，介紹集合的基本概念，並練習在集合中進行數量統計。

Thematic Activity
